The converter should auto-detect the video signal from your scoring. If there are geometry issues it is better to correct this using the controls on your monitors. Most monitors have a 'best fit' or 'auto-adjust' option. We recommend that you use this as it will ensure that all your monitors are adjusted the same.

The converter boards can be adjusted manually (although this is not recommended), but with some scoring systems it may be necessary. To do this you will need to remove the top cover of the enclosure.

The three potentiometers in the left hand corner of each board allow you to adjust the levels of the incoming Red, Green and Blue analogue video signals.



The four push-buttons in the right hand corner of each board allow access to a menu system. These menus contain all the picture geometry, quality and resolution settings.

Pushing the 'SW' button will change the input mode between RGBS, RGBHV and YpYbR. The board will attempt to auto-detect the input signal on power-up.

Unless you are dealing with a 'difficult' input signal, the best results will be achieved with the 'Default' geometry settings and the display size set to 800 x 600. Let your monitor deal with expanding the 4:3 format output to 16:9.
